The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional ten per cent of basic pay with Dearness Allowance (DA) to the petitioners, in terms of Clause 11 of the Teachers Transfer Policy, 2022. The claim is based on account of their posting in Nuh District as PGTs.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the Department vide memo dated 22.01.2026, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. Referring to the same, he contends that the benefit due in terms of the applicable policy has been released to the petitioner as per details mentioned in the instructions which are as under:

In this regard, it is submitted that as per the report received from DEO, Mewat the additional benefits in terms of

amendment dated 13.04.2022 of Teacher Transfer Policy, 2022 has been released to the petitioners. The additional benefits from the date of Transfer Drive, 2022 till July 2024 was already released vide Pay Order No 2207033734 dated 20.09.2024 (Copy attached). Further, the additional benefits for the months of August 2024 to October, 2024 has been released to the petitioners along with their respective salaries. Further, the additional benefits from November 2024 to December 2025 has been released vide Pay Order No 2207038992 dated 13.01.2026 (Copy attached).

These facts are not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. Since the claimed benefit has already been given to the petitioners, nothing survives for adjudication.

4. Disposed of.
