The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing of order dated 12.03.2010 (Annexure P-3) passed in Mutation No. 2483 of village Rauni, Tehsil and District Patiala, order dated 13.04.2011 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Collector, Sub Division Patiala, order dated 20.09.2011 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned District Collector, Patiala, order dated 31.03.2015 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala and order dated 21.08.2025 (Annexure P-11) passed by learned Financial Commissioner in ROR No. 657-2015
