The instant petition has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No.21, dated 09.02.2024, under Sections 304 IPC, (Sections 21 and 29 of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana Rural.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 20.11.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required for investigation of the case.

3. Learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Gurmit Singh, corroborates the said averment and submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.



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- 4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
- 5. Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is **allowed** and the interim order dated 20.11.2025 is made absolute.
- 6. However, if required, the petitioner(s) shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so.
