This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), for anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No.125 dated 04.10.2025 under Sections 109, 125, 111, 190 and 191(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25, 25(6), 25(7)(i) and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Offence under Sections 61(2)(a) BNS 2023 stands added and Section 25 Arms Act stands deleted later on) Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran.

2. Vide order dated 20.11.2025, the petitioner(s) was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. It was also directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation.



3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner(s) that in compliance with order dated 20.11.2025 the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation.
4. The learned State Counsel has filed the status report and has submitted on instructions of ASI Salwinder Singh that the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation, and that for further investigation of this case his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions and the fact that the petitioner(s) has already joined the investigation, the order dated 20.11.2025, granting interim anticipatory bail to him, is hereby made absolute. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
