SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 01.08.2025 passed in CWP-21953-2025, whereby, without commenting upon the merits of the case, writ petition was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for respondent contends that in compliance of order dated 01.08.2025, affidavit of Mr. Niraj, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Commissioner, Hisar, dated 06.04.2026 along with speaking order dated 01.04.2026, attached as Annexure R-1, has been filed. The same is taken on the record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. A perusal of speaking order dated 01.04.2026 shows that order dated 01.08.2025 passed in CWP-21953-2025 has been complied with.



4. In view of the same, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.

5. Needless to say that liberty is however granted to the petitioner to challenge the speaking order dated 01.04.2026 in accordance with law.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
