1. This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), for anticipatory bail in a case arising out of FIR No.108 dated 08.08.2025 under Sections 115, 121(1), 132, 324(3), 351(2) [Section 238 added later on] of BNS, 2023, Sections 27 and 29 of Indian Forest Act, 1927 and Sections 32 and 33 of Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, Police Station Pratap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with order dated 21.11.2025, whereby the benefit of interim anticipatory bail was afforded to the petitioner, the petitioner has joined investigation.

3. The learned State counsel, on the instructions of ASI Ramesh Kumar has submitted that the custody of petitioner, who has already joined investigation, is no longer required for further investigation of this case.
4. In view of above-mentioned submissions, the order dated 21.11.2025, whereby the benefit of interim bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
5. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
