The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS in case bearing FIR No.237 dated 05.10.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 191(3), 190, 351(3), 324(4) of BNS and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 109 of BNS added later on), at Police Station City1 Abohar, District Fazilka.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.11.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
