1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), seeking regular bail in FIR No. 449 dated 14.10.2021, under Sections 201, 392, 397 of IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jind, Haryana.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all prosecution witnesses have been examined before the trial Court.

3. Since counsel for the petitioner is acknowledging the fact that statements of all the prosecution witnesses have already been recorded, this Court refrains from entertaining the plea of bail at this stage, however, noticing the fact that petitioner is already inside jail for the last more than a period of 04 years and 04 months and other co-accused are released on bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the case expeditiously within three months.

No further extension shall be granted thereafter.
