1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of orders dated 21.11.2023, 21.07.2003 and 08.02.2023
2. Notice of motion.
3. On asking of the Court, Mr. Vivek Sharma, Advocate for Mr. Shubham Chaudhary and Ms. Deepali Puri, Advocates, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 2 and respondent No. 3 respectively.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents contends that that the petitioners have previously also filed COCP No. 1546 and 1630-2015, which was disposed of and the rule was discharged, vide order dated 08.02.2023.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the whole file of this case with their able assistance.
6. A perusal of the file shows that the petitioners have previously filed COCP No. 1546 and 1630-2015 and the same stands disposed of by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 08.02.2023. No liberty was granted to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition or to file a fresh one.
