HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

1. At the very outset, the contemner, who appears in person, deeply regrets the incident which had taken place and tenders his unconditional apology for the same with the assurance that no such incident will happen in rest of his career before any Court of Law and he should be given another opportunity to show that he will conduct himself in a manner required. An affidavit to this effect has also been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

2. Keeping in view the repentance of the contemner for the alleged incident, coupled with the fact that he has tendered unconditional apology for the same and has shown remorse for his act, with the further undertaking that no such incident will happen again, the proceedings against the



contemner are dropped with the observation that, in case, any such incident happens in future, not only the action would be taken for such incident but even the present proceedings will be reopened. Accordingly, the contempt petition stands disposed of in above stated terms.
