1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing/setting aside the impugned order dated 16.09.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Malerkotla in case bearing CHI No.79 of 2023 titled as '*State v. Mohammad Salim @ Simu and others*', whereby, bail of the petitioners has been cancelled and their bail/surety bonds have been forfeited to State and non-bailable warrants were issued as well as subsequent order dated 27.10.2025 (Annexure P-3), wherein fresh non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioners.

2. On the last date of hearing, a request for adjournment was made on behalf of the petitioners. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

3. Learned State counsel appeared on advance notice and submitted that on 16.09.2025, the petitioners failed to appear before the trial Court, on



27.10.2025 as well as on 06.01.2026, the petitioners did not appear before the trial Court and their arrest warrants were issued on all these dates. As such, learned State counsel prayed for dismissal of the present petition.

4. Heard.
5. Keeping in view the fact that despite having knowledge regarding issuance of non-bailable warrants qua them, the petitioners are not appearing before the trial Court and today, the counsel for the petitioners did not appear before this Court. So, taking into consideration the act and conduct of the petitioners, this Court finds no merit in the present petition and the same stands dismissed accordingly.
