The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, (Section 438 Cr.P.C.) for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.102 dated 11.06.2025, under Section(s) 115(2), 118(1), 190 and 191(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Section 109 and 118(2) of the BNS 2023 added later on), and Section 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that pursuant to

the order dated 13.01.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for further investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from assisting police official, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 13.01.2026 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner(s) shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
