1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.148 dated 15.08.2025, registered under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 351(3), 61(2) of BNS, 2023, at Police Station Saha, District Ambala.

2. By virtue of order dated 18.03.2026, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved by way of compromise. He has further submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their issue by way of compromise.

However, he submits that in view of the terms and conditions of the

compromise arrived at between the parties, the petitioner has to pay the amount to the complainant on or before 30.09.2026. He, thus, submits that the complainant be granted liberty to file cancellation of bail granted to the petitioner, in case he violates the terms and conditions of the compromised arrived at between them.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

7. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case and the compromise arrived at between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.03.2026 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. However, it is made clear that the petitioner would be bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise and in case of any violation of terms and conditions of the compromise or if any fresh cause of action accrues to the complainant, the complainant would be at liberty as prayed for.
