SUMEET GOEL, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross version case registered vide GD No.028 dated 22.04.2022, registered under Sections 326, 506, 148 & 149 of IPC, at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural, which is being investigated in case FIR No.60 dated 15.04.2022, registered for offences punishable under Sections 307, 148 & 149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural.

2. On 12.12.2025, the following order was passed:-

“Apprehending his arrest in cross version case registered vide GD No.028 dated 22.04.2022, registered under Sections 326, 506, 148 & 149 of IPC, at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural, which is being investigated in case FIR No.60 dated 15.04.2022, registered for offences punishable under Sections 307, 148 & 149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at



Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural; the petitioner has preferred this second petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking pre-arrest bail.

Inter alia contends that the FIR in question was registered at the instance of the petitioner, the petitioner has been falsely implicated into the GDibid by the accused-side in the FIR so as to over the impediment being faced by them, the allegations against the petitioner is that he has given a blow with datar on the left leg (below the knee) of the injured, the said injury is purely a measure of self-defence, the petitioner has clean antecedents, & the petitioner is willing to join investigation and cooperate therein. Notice of motion.

On the strength of advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Adhiraj Singh Thind, AAG Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent– State of Punjab.

Put up on 15.01.2026.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 17.12.2025 at 11:00 A.M. in concerned Police Station and join investigation. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when further called by Investigating Officer, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the condition(s) enumerated under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 12.12.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

4. Keeping in view the factual milieu of the case in hand; especially the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated therein and is no longer required by the State for further custodial interrogation, this Court is inclined to confirm the order dated 12.12.2025, granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. This order should not be treated as “blanket” order. It will not be read granting petitioner indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be



confined to the FIR mentioned *ibid* and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.

7. Liberty is reserved in favour of State/complainant to move for cancellation/recall of this order in case the petitioner violates any condition stipulated under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023 or upon showing any other sufficient cause.

8. Needless to say that anything observed herein above shall not be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
