The petition has been filed seeking a direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to protect the petitioner's life and liberty, and provide adequate security to him. He is statedly facing threats from gangsters, and has given representations to the respondents, the latest ones being dated 26.11.2025, Annexures P-3 to P-7.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the Union of India contends that the petitioner's representation dated 26.11.2025, Annexure P-4, received by Union of India, has already been forwarded to the State Government for appropriate action.

3. Learned State counsel submits that aforementioned representations will be looked into by the third respondent/Commissioner of

Police, Amritsar, and prompt action, as required, to protect the petitioner's life and liberty will be taken in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
