This is first petition filed under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 17.05.2025 registered under Sections 115, 127(2), 140(4), 190, 191(3), 351(2) but later on charged under 127(2) read with Section 190, 191(3), 140(4) read with Section 190, 115(2) read with Section 190, 351, read with Section 190 of BNS registered at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is seeking regular bail on the ground of parity. Co-accused, namely, Akshay @ Akash, has already been released on bail by this Court vide order dated 05.12.2025 (Annexure P.3) and co-accused namely Sagar, Harjot Agnihotri and Ajay Saini have been released on bail vide order dated 04.12.2025 passed by this Court. The case of the applicant- petitioner is similar to that of co-accused Akshay @ Akash, who has already been released on bail.



3. Accordingly, in view of detailed reasons recorded in the bail application bearing CRM-M-67558 of 2025 – **Akshay @ Akash Vs. State of Haryana**, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
