SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 483 read with Section 528 of BNS for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.21 dated 26.09.2025 under Sections 178, 179, 180 of BNS registered at Police Station-Crime, Police Station, Sector-11, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the father of the petitioner is not well and has been suffering from paralysis; recently his father suffered a heart attack and has been advised surgery. As such, he prays for concession of interim regular bail on the ground that there is no one to take care of his father.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent-U.T. on instructions from SI-Om Parkash vehemently opposes the grant of interim regular bail while submitting that the allegations against the



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petitioner are serious in nature; however submits that the petitioner is having one brother who can take care of his father.

4. Heard.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and the rival contentions raised by learned counsel for the parties; the fact that the petitioner is having one brother who can take care of his father; and the allegations against the present petitioner are serious in nature, this Court does not find merit in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
