1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for quashing of order dated 29.08.2025 passed by the trial Court in Complaint case No. 2115/2020 titled as “*Vijender Yadav Versus Ashish Gupta*” under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, whereby petitioner was declared as ‘Proclaimed Person’.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 18.12.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. He further submits that costs of Rs.5000/- has also been deposited by the petitioner.

3. Despite service, no one has appeared on behalf of the respondent.

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Since the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and



has been released on interim bail, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 18.12.2025 (*ibid*) is made absolute.

6. However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
