1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 439 Cr.P.C.), for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, during the pendency of trial, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed here-under:-

2. Total four accused were named in the FIR in question on the basis of suspicion by the complainant – Parveen (brother of the deceased – Sanjay Rana). The said four suspects named in the FIR are: (i) Gaurav; (ii) Rahul; (iii) Deepak @ Atul; and (iv) Ishan.

After investigation, accused Ishan was found innocent; however, he has now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Besides,



one eye-witness, namely Shiv Om (PW-3), has appeared before the learned trial Court on 11.10.2024 and has supported the case of the prosecution.

3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition at this stage.

4. **Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.**
