1. Learned Single Judge has dismissed the contempt petition after noticing the fact that the writ petition, the order passed wherein is alleged to have been violated, had already been dismissed as withdrawn. Consequently, the contempt petition has been dismissed.
2. We fail to understand how an appeal under Section 19 has been filed against such an order when the scope of Section 19 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is otherwise limited. Even otherwise, the writ petition was for the disposal of a representation, which has already been rejected.
3. In that view of the matter, the instant contempt appeal is ***dismissed.***
4. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
