1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail for the petitioner in FIR No.0214, dated 03.11.2017 under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

2. This Court, vide order dated 22.12.2025, had directed the petitioner to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.12.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation. He has produced the copy of order dated



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4. Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.
5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 22.12.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
