SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. This petition for pre-arrest bail, which is first petition, has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. This petition is with regard to a case arising out of FIR No.179 dated 11.07.2025, for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 125, 190, 191(3), 287, 305, 324(4), 329(3), 331(4), 351(2), 62 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, (Sections 61 and 351(3) of BNS added later on) and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

2. Vide order dated 04.02.2026, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety



bonds to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer. It was also directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with order dated 04.02.2026, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. The learned State Counsel, on the instructions of ASI Jaspal Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, and that for further investigation of this case his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions and the fact that the petitioner has already join the investigation, the order dated 04.02.2026, granting interim anticipatory bail to him, is hereby made absolute. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
