1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking grant of regular bail, in case, FIR No.33, dated 07.05.2025, under Sections 103(1), 61(1) of BNS (corresponding to sections 302 and 120-B of IPC), registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.
2. Deceased-Rajvir Kaur, was the wife of present petitioner and is alleged to have been murdered. Post-mortem report indicates one injury mark on the right side of the neck and another beneath the chin on the left side of the deceased.
3. In view of the above, this Court finds no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner, at this stage.
4. Hence, present petition stands dismissed, at this stage.
