1. Present second petition has been filed praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.162 dated 26.10.2024 under Sections 318(4), 351(2), 61(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.
2. Learned counsel for the State, at the outset, has submitted that out of total 15 prosecution witnesses, 11 witnesses have already been examined and the co-accused is yet to be arrested. She thus, submits that the trial is at the fag end.
3. In view of the submissions made, it is apparent that the trial is at the fag end. Thus, keeping in view the stage of the trial, this Court refrains itself from going into the merits of the case. However, learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
