The prayer in the present petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for issuance of appropriate directions for conducting a fair and impartial investigation; for addition of offences under Sections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(f) and 3(1)(g) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, along with other relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, in FIR No. 0407 dated 02.10.2025 registered under Section 305 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sector 13/17, District Panipat, Haryana; and for issuance of directions for arrest of the accused persons and registration of an FIR against the erring police officials.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the Investigating Agency is mixed up with the accused persons. Therefore, the FIR has been diluted inasmuch as offences under the SC and ST Act have been deleted. Further, the accused have not been arrested till date.

Therefore, appropriate directions be issued in that regard.

3. On the other hand, the learned State counsel while referring to the reply dated 29.01.2026, contends that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are baseless. In fact, the dispute between the parties has been found to be of civil nature and Narender (petitioner) is not the owner of the land in question. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.

4. Heard.

5. Without going into the rival contentions of either side, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat to look into the grievance of the petitioner and proceed in accordance with law.
