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**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release payment with respect to work carried out by it for the respondent along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned State counsel on instruction from Mr. Mahender Singh, Executive Engineer, M.C. Faridabad, Division-II submits that competent authority would consider petitioner's claim and if any admitted liability is found, it would be discharged within four months from today.



3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the petition stands **disposed of** with a direction to respondent to release payment to the petitioner within four months from today failing which would be liable to pay interest @ 9% per annum from the expiry of said period.
