1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking issuance of a Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondent nos. 1 and 2 to produce the daughter of the petitioner, namely Ms. Aarju Yadav, arrayed as the respondent no. 3 herein.

2. Pursuant to our order dated 05.02.2026, the respondent no. 3, Ms. Aarju Yadav, has appeared before us in person, and we have

5. At this stage, the respondent no. 3 submits that some of her original documents are lying with the petitioner at her parental home. The petitioner, who appears in person, assures that any original documents of the respondent no. 3 that may be available with him, would be returned to the respondent no. 3 forthwith.

6. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
