1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking following reliefs:-

- a) *Allow the present Petition being filed under Article 226 of the Constitution.*
- b) *Pass a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, thereby quashing and setting aside the impugned order dated 20.12.2025 passed by the Learned Debts Recovery Tribunal, Jaipur in Securitization Application No. 414/2025;*
- c) *Pass a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, thereby quashing and setting aside the order dated 17.12.2025 passed by the Learned Debts Recovery Tribunal, Jaipur,*



whereby time was granted to the petitioner to file its reply.

2. At the outset, a preliminary objection, with respect to the maintainability of the present writ petition to the extent that whether the challenge to an impugned Order passed by the learned DRT would lie under Article 226 of the Constitution of India or not, was raised by the learned counsel for respondent No. 1.

3. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India before the appropriate Court/forum.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition along with pending applications stand disposed of as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for, in accordance with law.
