1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:

“1. Issue the writ of mandamus directing the R-2 to provide the “NEET UG 2019 score Card” of the Petitioner.

2. Issue the writ of mandamus directing the R-1 for accepting the “Score Card” provided by the R- 2 in due Course.

3. Issue the writ of mandamus directing R-3 for accepting the “Score Card” for the purpose of provisional or permanent registration, after qualifying the FMG Exam, in Indian Medical Register as per Section 13(4A), Section 21, Section22, Section23 and Section 25 of Indian Medical Council Act,1956...”

2. The brief facts of the case are that the petitioner is a medical degree holder from a foreign University and she has to appear for Foreign



Medical Graduate Examination (**“FMGE”**), conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (**“NBEMS”**). However, the Information Bulletin issued by NBEMS for FMGE December-2025 Session, requires that Indian citizens/ overseas citizen of India intending to obtain primary medical qualification from any medical institution outside India on/after May 2018 shall have to mandatorily qualify NEET for admission to MBBS course and result of NEET for admission to MBBS course shall be deemed to be treated as eligibility certificate for such candidates.

3. The petitioner has inadvertently lost her NEET UG 2019 Scorecard.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent No. 2, namely National Testing Agency (**“NTA”**) has furnished particulars of the petitioner as available in their database, and the same can be perused by this court to issue direction to treat this order as a NEET UG 2019 Scorecard.
5. The respondent No. 2, has filed an Affidavit mentioning relevant details and particulars of the petitioner, which reads as under:-

6. Accordingly, National Board of Examination in Medical Science (respondent No.1) is directed to treat this Order as a Scorecard for NEET UG 2019 examination in respect of the petitioner and consequently, the requirement on part of the petitioner to furnish Scorecard of NEET UG 2019 for FMGE 2025 and also for future FMGE Examinations is dispensed with.
7. The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
