W.P.(C) 609/2026

1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“(a) quashing of Impugned Withdrawal Order dated 27.05.2025 of NRC, thereby, withdrawing recognition of the Petitioner Institution for running the D.EL.ED. course;

(b) direct the respondent no.2 to issue restoration of recognition order to the petitioner institution, thereby restoring its recognition with all consequential benefits of being a recognized institution; in respect of aforesaid D.EL.ED course of petitioner institution,

(c) direct the respondent no.2 to consequently open the link,



*whereon petitioner can upload and get updated its record,
(d) direct the respondent no.2 to update its record on website
by displaying the recognized status of petitioner.”*

2. Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel for the respondents states that the present matter is covered by the judgment of a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed in a batch of similar petitions, one of them being ***Teachers Training College Mirza v. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr., W.P.(C) 5369/2025***, order dated 15.12.2025.
3. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed, holding that the directions passed by the Coordinate Bench in paragraphs Nos. 12 to 16 in the judgment of ***Teachers Training College Mirza (supra)*** shall apply to the petitioner, including the direction to permit the petitioner to participate in the counselling session for the academic session 2025-26.
4. All respondents shall ensure that petitioner is permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-26.
5. The writ petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
