W.P.(C) 668/2026

1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“(a) Issue a Writ of Certiorari and Quash the Withdrawal Order dt. 28.05.2025, withdrawing recognition of petitioner institution for running the D.EL.ED course from academic year 2025-2026; and;

(b) Issue a Writ of Mandamus directing Respondent No.2 to issue restoration of recognition of petitioner institution for D.EL.ED course from Academic Year 2025-2026; and;

(c) Issue a Writ of Mandamus enabling the petitioner to participate in counselling and admit students for D.EL.ED



course for Academic Year 2025-2026...”

2. Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel for the respondents states that the present matter is covered by the judgment of a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed in a batch of similar petitions, one of them being ***Teachers Training College Mirza v. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr., W.P.(C) 5369/2025***, order dated 15.12.2025.
3. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed, holding that the directions passed by the Coordinate Bench in paragraph Nos. 12 to 16 in the judgment of ***Teachers Training College Mirza (supra)*** shall apply to the petitioner, including the direction to permit the petitioner to participate in the counselling session for the academic session 2025-26.
4. All respondents shall ensure that petitioner is permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-26.
5. The writ petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
