1. This petition has been filed with the following prayers:-

- “1. Allow the present Petition and issue a writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction thereby quash the Orders dated 22.05.2025 and 19.12.2025 passed by the Ld. Armed Force Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi in Original Application no.2118 of 2024 titled as “Inderjit Kaur W/o Major Rajinder Singh vs Union of India & Ors.”;*
- 2. Allow the present Petition and issue a writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction to the Ld. Armed Force Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi to decide and dispose of the Original Application no.2118 of 2024 titled as “Inderjit Kaur W/o Major Rajinder Singh vs Union of India & Ors.” at the earliest or in a time bound manner;*
