1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:

“It is therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

a) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the Respondents to accept the resignation dated 09.10.2025 of the Petitioner in a time bound manner;

b) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the Respondents to release the benefits accruing to the Petitioner subsequent to his resignation from the service in a time bound manner; ...”

2. The only submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the respondent should accept the resignation dated 09.10.2025 as followed by the representation dated 20.11.2025 of the petitioner intending to resign from the
