ORDER

20.01.2026

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1. By virtue of the present petition under *Article 226* of the Constitution of India read with *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*BNSS*), the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:-

“a. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction quashing the arrest of the Petitioner dated 16.01.2026 as illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional;

b. Direct the immediate release of the Petitioner, declaring the detention to be violative of Articles 21 and 22(1) of the Constitution of India;

c. Declare that the custodial interrogation and detention of the Petitioner at the office of Respondent No.3 are illegal and without authority of law;



d. Grant any other relief(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file the same before appropriate forum(s) in accordance with law.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
