The matter is taken up today in view of Notification No.64/G-4/Genl.-
I/DHC dated 27.02.2026.

1. None appears for the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that an office order dated 24.04.2026 has been issued by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi in compliance with the directions contained in the order dated 10.04.2026 passed in SLP (C) diary no. 18812/2026 read with judgment dated 26.09.2025 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) 8402/2021 (non-compliance of which has been alleged in the present petition). The said office order reads as under:

OFFICE ORDER

In Compliance of order dated 10.04.2026 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP(C) diary No. 18812/2026 titled as Municipal Corporation of Delhi Vs. A.K.Dixit and Judgment dated 26.09.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in WP(C) No. 8402/2021 titled as A.K.Dixit Vs. The Commissioner, North Delhi Municipal Corporation, Sh. A.K.Dixit S/o Sh. K.N.Dixit, SE(Civil) (Retd.) (earlier compulsorily retired from the services of erstwhile North Delhi Municipal Corporation vide office order CMR/NDMC/2019/D-453 dated 31.10.2019), is hereby deemed reinstated in service of Municipal Corporation of Delhi w.e.f. 31.10.2019 till he reached the age of superannuation i.e. on 31.07.2023 (Date of birth-30.07.1963) as Superintending Engineer (Civil)(adhoc). He shall be entitled to all consequential reliefs in accordance with the law, including the benefit of notional fixation of pay and other consequential benefits, but without arrears of pay.

2. Further, the payments, terminal benefits or any other benefits made earlier in lieu of the abovesaid compulsory retirement under 56 (j) to Sh. A.K.Dixit, Superintending Engineer (Civil) shall be adjusted/recovered as per law by the concerned DDO of Engineering Department in consultation/concurrence with Finance/Accounts/Pension Department.

3. This order will be subject to outcome of Court Case Review Petition No. 99/2026 in WP(C) No. 8402/2021, titled as A.K.Dixit Vs. The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Delhi.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
