1. The present appeal has been filed under Section 13 of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 against the Judgment/Order dated 11.11.2025 passed by the learned District Judge (Commercial Court), West District, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi in CS(COMM.)
