1. By virtue of the present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India Constitution read with *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (**BNSS**), the petitioner seeks direction to the respondent to release the petitioner on parole for a period of *four weeks*.
