ORDER

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02.02.2026

1. This is a petition filed with the following prayers:

“a) Issue a Writ in the nature of certiorari or Mandamus or such other appropriate writ or orders quashing the salary slip (wrongful deduction of Rs. 10,754) for the month of January 2026 issued by Office of Director General, I.T.B.P as arbitrary, illegal and against the policy of I.T.B.P.

b) Decide the representation dated 27.01.2026 made to the Respondent I.T.B.P officials.

c) Pass any such further order/order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.”

2. The submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the respondents have recovered an amount of Rs. 10,754/- from the salary which was paid for the month of January, 2026.



3. He states that there is an apprehension that alike amount may also be recovered from the salary of the petitioner which is to be paid for the month of February, 2026.
4. He states that, appropriate shall be, that the respondents should decide the representation dated 27.01.2026 made by the petitioner herein, which submission is agreeable to the counsel for the respondents.
5. Accordingly, we direct, that the respondents shall decide the representation dated 27.01.2026 within a period of six weeks from today. Till the time the representation dated 27.01.2026 is decided, no recovery shall be made by the respondents from the salary of the petitioner.
6. The present petition is disposed of. Pending application is dismissed.
