2. The present Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondents to produce the detenu, Shri Uddhab Nahak before this Court.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly, at the outset itself, submits that by an order dated 04.02.2026, passed by the



learned ACJM-01, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi, in the above-mentioned FIR, the petitioner has been directed to be released on bail. Further action contemplated in terms of the judgment of the Supreme Court in SLP (Crl.) 5191/2021, titled ***Satender Kumar Antil v. CBI & Anr.***, has also been deferred. He submits that, in view of the above order, the petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
