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1. Status report is taken on record.
2. Testimony of victim is underway and she has already been examined in part.
3. After hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for applicant submits that though the period of incarceration is quite substantial one but he may be permitted to withdraw the present bail application with liberty to file it afresh after the testimony of victim is recorded.
4. Bail application is accordingly disposed of as not pressed.
5. Liberty, as prayed, is granted.

7. However, on the date fixed before the learned Trial Court i.e. 14.05.2026, the prosecution would ensure the presence of victim before the learned Trial Court.
