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1. By virtue of the present petition under *Article* 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (**Cr.P.C**), the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.481/2025 dated 02.07.2025 registered under *Sections* 420/468/471/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (**IPC**) at PS.: Narela, Delhi, and all proceedings emanating therefrom.
