1. Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.517/2025 dated 16.10.2025, registered at P.S. Subzi Mandi, for commission of offences under Sections 74/79/115(2)/304(2)/3(5) of *Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS)*, 2023 (corresponding Sections 354/509/323/34 IPC).
2. According to petitioner, who is a practicing Advocate, the abovesaid FIR has been got registered by his erstwhile client on totally false, frivolous and non-existing reasons and, therefore, it needs to be quashed.
3. Admittedly, there is a cross-FIR in which there are certain allegations made by the petitioner herein against his such client i.e. respondent No.2 herein.
4. Both the cases are, reportedly, pending investigation.
5. After hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, without prejudice to her rights and contentions, does not press the



present petition at this stage. She, however, submits that she may be granted liberty to file petition afresh at a subsequent stage, as and when need so arises.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of not pressed. Liberty, as prayed, is granted.

7. Pending application also stands disposed of.
