1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“(a) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus quashing the Impugned Notifications dated 04.09.2025 and 15.09.2025 issued by the Respondent No. 2 under the aegis of Respondent No.1 in so far as it does not provide for registration for additional subject to private candidates;

(b) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondent No.2 under the aegis of Respondent



No.1 to permit private candidates including the Petitioners to register for examination in additional subject category;

(c) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondent No. 2 under the aegis of Respondent No.1 to permit the Petitioners and other similarly placed students to appear in the CBSE examination as private candidates;

(d) Issue rule nisi in terms of prayer clause (a), (b) and (c) above;”

2. The matter is covered by the judgment in W.P.(C) 15086/2025, dated 05.02.2026 upheld by the Division Bench in judgment passed in LPA 72/2026, dated 19.02.2026.
3. Granting the same relief, the petition is allowed, along with pending applications, if any.
4. The required steps shall be taken within 1 week from the date of uploading of this order.
5. The petition is disposed of.
