1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

CONT.CAS(C) 350/2026

3. The present petition is premised on allegation of wilful disobedience/non-compliance of the directions contained in the order dated 08.01.2026 passed by this Court in CRL.MC. No. 935/2023. The operative direction therein reads as under:-

4. After some hearing, learned counsel for both sides submit that these petitions may be disposed of with the following directions:

- a. Interim maintenance of Rs. 50,000/- per month fixed by the Mahila Court vide order dated 21.02.2019, as affirmed by the Sessions Court vide judgment dated 06.01.2023, will continue to operate, for the present.
- b. All arrears of payment will be made by the husband to the wife within a period of six weeks from today, after adjustment of the aforesaid amount of Rs. 50,00,000/-. Learned counsel on both sides accept that the amount of Rs. 25,00,000/- remains due to the wife, in terms of the said orders.
- c. The parties are free to approach the Mahila Court for modification of the amount of interim maintenance, which will be decided by the Mahila Court in accordance with law.
- d. Needless to say, these arrangements are not intended to constitute any expression of opinion, either with regard to the interim maintenance or the final orders to be passed by the Mahila Court under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, or to affect the merits of any other litigation between the parties.



4. It transpires during the course of hearing that the amount of Rs. 25,00,000/- has been paid to the petitioner in terms of direction contained in Paragraph 4(b) of the aforesaid order dated 08.01.2026 *albeit* with some delay.
5. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that not only has the payment of Rs. 25,00,000/- been paid, the respondent shall continue to pay the interim maintenance amount of Rs. 50,000/- per month to the petitioner in terms of the aforesaid order on/ or before 07th day of every month.
6. Given the aforesaid undertaking/ commitment of the respondent, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
7. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
