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1. By virtue of the present bail application under *Sections 483 and 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (***BNSS***), the applicant seeks grant of interim bail in FIR No.271/2019 dated 14.08.2019 under *Sections 302/307/34* of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (***IPC***) read with *Sections 25/54* of the Arms Act, 1959 at PS: Patel Nagar, Delhi.
