1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application is disposed of.

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3. By virtue of the present application under *Section 483* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (**BNSS**), the applicant seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.09/2025 dated 06.01.2025 registered at PS.: South Rohini, Delhi under *Section 281/105/110* of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (**BNS**) and *Section 185* of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
4. Since the applicant's last bail application filed before the learned Trial Court was dismissed *vide* order dated 25.02.2026 on the very same grounds



which has been taken by him in the present application, as also since, *admittedly*, there are no changes in the circumstances since then, learned counsel for the applicant seeks to withdraw the present application with liberty to take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
