1. After hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for petitioner, without prejudice to her rights and contentions, seeks to withdraw the present petition. She, however, submits that since the petitioner had never consented for grant of maintenance @ Rs. 7,000/- per month to his wife, she would move appropriate application before the concerned Trial Court.
