1. By way of the present applications, the applicants seek grant of regular bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in connection with FIR No. 10/2025 dated 08.03.2025, registered at Cyber Police Station, Outer North District, Delhi, under Sections 318(4), 61(2), and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Mr. Yudhvair Singh Chauhan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, points out at the outset that, in both these cases, the applicants were granted interim bail, which was extended by the learned Sessions Court from time to time until 05.02.2026.
