By virtue of the present petition under *Article 226* of the Constitution of India read with *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (**BNSS**), the petitioner seeks issuance of Writ in the nature of *Mandamus* granting him parole for a period of *eight weeks* in FIR No. 569/2000 registered at PS.: Preet Vihar, Delhi under *Sections 364-A/34* of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (**IPC**).
