ORDER
18.03.2026

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1. The accused/applicant seeks regular bail in case FIR No. 328/2025 of PS Crime Branch for offence under Section 20/29 NDPS Act.
2. Broadly speaking, according to prosecution case, 366 grams *charas* from the accused/applicant and 977.5 gram *charas* from co-accused were recovered and the total recovery becomes the commercial quantity. In this regard, prosecution contends that charge under Section 29 NDPS Act is made out. This contention of prosecution is strongly disputed by learned counsel for accused/applicant, who claims that even according to prosecution case, the alleged recovery from the accused/applicant was nearing small quantity.



3. After part arguments, learned counsel for accused/applicant seeks permission to withdraw this bail application with liberty to file afresh before the trial court after consideration of charge by the trial court, for which the matter is already listed on 27.03.2026.
4. As requested, this bail application and the accompanying application are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as sought.
